This diverse selection of excellently made Champagnes offers a journey from the bright and zingy to the complex and fully rich. They are all great value, so that you may experience a different style for different occasions. Our advice? Try them all! (though not all at once). Santé!

The Cuvées Btl

Champagne Devaux, Coeur de Nature (bio-organic)

65

This expressive Blanc de Noir is Devaux's first fully certified organic Champagne. With a low dosage of 5g/l, it retains a zingy freshness. 30% are from reserve wines, whilst this cuvée is aged for 5 years, 2 of which on the lees. The grapes are soley picked from the Côte des Bar, with a process that cements Devaux's position as one of the front runners of sustainable viticulture. Eric Label, Chef de Cave of Krug, refers to Devaux as "The Krug of the Côte des Bar."

Champagne Taittinger, Brut Réserve

65

Synonymous with quality, prestige and elegance, this is a delicately balanced cuvée enjoyed around the world. 40% Chardonnay and 60% Pinot Noir & Meunier, this brut reserve has been aged for three years. It delivers aromas of brioche, white flowers, peach and vanilla pod. The brut reserve offers consistency in every bottle, every year.

Champagne Louis Roederer, Collection 245

This cuvée bears the innovative approach in some Champagnes, capturing the essence of the year's harvest in the blend, whilst not entirely made of one vintage. The 245th blend takes advantage of the 2020 harvest, with grapes only from Roederer's estate. 41% Chardonnay and equal measure of Pinot Noir & Meunier, a high 45% of the wine is made from a perpetual reserve, 10% of which is aged in oak. Making a crisp, ripe and intense Champagne.

Champagne Pol Roger, Réserve Brut

This renowned house produces an elegant and refined brut reserve, made of equal parts of the three champagne grapes. They use 25% reserve wines to ensure consistency & style. Four years of aging in the cellars produce a harmonious and pleasant freshness, long lasting aromas of both fruity and spicy notes. Most notably Winston Churchills' favourite tipple!

Champagne Charles Heidsieck, Brut Réserve

65

A big and beautifully complex cuvée with an incredible 50% reserve wine. 10% of which is aged in old Burgundy oak barrels to further deepen its complexity. 40% in equal measure Chardonnay & Pinot Noir. This cuvée is elegant beyond its years, with roasted notes and brioche aromas. The persistent tight bubbles show signs of a long maturing process. Hands down, an incredible journey for the taste buds.

Champagne Lanson, Le Blanc de Blancs

65

With Chardonnays selected from 15 Crus, including 9 Grand crus and Premier Crus and with the wine Aging for 4 years, this cuvee has developed complexity and vibrancy. 40% of this wine is from reserves giving fullness and balance. Marzipan, dried fruits and woody hints are noted on the palate. A touch of chalkiness gives way to a saline delicate and pure finish. This cuvee is delicate yet complex, Fresh and zesty.



Fine Wines from the Cellar

A small selection of fine wines, now drinking perfectly, have been chosen by our Wine Committee for you to enjoy. With the aid of our Coravin system, we literally tap into these excellent wines whilst perfectly preserving the remaining wine, so you may sample them as you wish by the glass. Only if you don't have time for a bottle. These wines are very limited so please do experience them while they last.

Burgundy Btl | 175ml | 125ml

Domaine Rossignol-Trapet, Beaune Premier Cru, Les Teurons, 2011

This is a ripe jammy wine, full of creamed-strawberry flavours. All this fruitiness is balanced by the acidity. The tannins are a comfortable cushion under the fruit.

Domaine Odoul-Coquard, Nuit St George "Les Argillats", Côte-d'Or, 2010

Sébastian Odoul is the latest generation of the family to join the team, making tremendous Wines. If you prefer soft and rounded but earthy Pinot Noir this is your choice.

Domaine Faiveley, Mercurey La Framboisière, Grand vin de Bourgogne, 2018

This wine from the Côte Chalonnaise is just lovely. Crunchy, juicy fruit, with notes of cumin and cinnamon. Mouthwatering, it's a wine perfect to drink now.

Bordeaux Btl | 175ml | 125ml

Roc de Cambe, Cote de Bourg, France 2006 48 | 12.60 | 9.00

A claret that seems to fly a little under the radar. Smooth as silk with rich and rounded dark fruit and soft tannins. Drinking well!

Chateau Batailley, Grand Cru, Pauillac, France 2009 48 | 12.60 | 9.00

Dense purple-coloured with a boatload of tannins as well as sweet, caramelised, blackcurrant fruit with hints of charcoal, cedarwood and smoke, with full-bodied, well-integrated tannins displaying no jaggedness. Just perfect with red meats.
